
We're caring for our local wetlands and surrounding bushland to safeguard our natural assets.

The group collaborates with village management and community members to plan future projects, enhance biodiversity, and maintain water quality so the area remains a vibrant, safe, and welcoming habitat for wildlife, residents and visitors.



Wetlands at Cardinia Waters Village are home to a rich diversity of birdlife and once the threatened Growling Grass Frog. Our activities aim to safeguard this habitat so residents can continue to enjoy the richness these species bring to the area.

Our plantings around the wetland create healthy habitat for a diversity of species. Our recent work has involved assisting in clearing aquatic weeds to ensure that healthy habitat extends below the water line.

Our hands-on care means we stay active and engaged with our local environment. This delivers health benefits not only to us, but also water quality, and the wildlife that feed, breed and shelter here.



Planting, weeding, pruning and controlling foxes – which predate on native waterbirds and frogs – are the mainstays of our activities at the wetlands. Our group prioritizes socializing in the outdoors so come along and enjoy the wetlands while you actively take part in its care.
